Courses for All Grassroots Leaders

Design Thinking and Residents' Journey Mapping New

This course provides learners with an appreciation of how to remodel community initiatives for the changing social landscape. Using one of the design thinking tools Journey Mapping, they will gain insights into understanding residents' behaviours, actions and motivations across different touchpoints of a community programme. Learners will also uncover areas of needs, improvements and innovation to develop more engaging and effective programmes.

Let's Talk About It: CommU&lcating Better New

Communication skills are at the very heart of building strong community relations. A good communicator is one who leverages strong social interaction skills to achieve win-win outcomes. For learners who interact frequently with community partners and residents, this course enables them to examine ways to have better conversations and overcome common barriers to communication for more effective community outreach and relationship-building.

Building Relationships - House Visit Engagement Skills

This course equips learners with the ability to engage and build trust with residents. It focuses on equipping learners with the skills to build and strengthen relationships with residents in the context of house visits.

Effective Self-Management

This course equips learners with the necessary knowledge and skills to better manage multiple priorities through efficient use of time. They will learn time management techniques which will increase their personal effectiveness as a grassroots leader. Learners will also have the opportunity to practise setting "SMART" goals and making decisions through creative thinking approach so that they can better evaluate options, decide on best course of action, and manage their time and priorities effectively.

Emotional Intelligence – Connecting with Self & Others

This course equips learners with the key pursuits of Six Seconds' Emotional Intelligence (EQ) model. The pursuits are translated into eight specific and achievable competencies that are applied to increase learners' self-awareness of emotions and strengthen their relationships with others.

Leadership in Practice

Introduction to Grassroots Financial Accounting System (G-FAST) for Office Bearers

Grassroots Financial Accounting System (G-FAST) is the new improved online accounting system replacing the PA Web-Based Accounting Template (PAT) used by 2,000 Grassroots Organisations (GROs) to prepare and submit their monthly accounts. G-FAST supports e-approvals and e-payments with in-built system controls designed to increase work efficiency, improve user experience and enhance compliance.

This course equips learners with the knowledge on how to 1) Create transactions such as Receipts, Transfers, Journals and Payments with Electronic Funds Transfer Mode; 2) Use reports to check the transactions; and 3) Perform bank reconciliation. Learners who are Approvers will learn how to approve payments and what to look out for before approving.

It also reinforces the importance of continuous learning and sharing among grassroots leaders to uphold principles of accountability ethics in grassroots finance.
